The 2004 Poggio al Vento is showing beautifully. It displays a fragrant complex nose of dark red fruit, herbs, and earth. It is soft and lush on the attack and packed with lots of flavor and complexity. Made for aging, the tannins are still hard but not abrasive and the wine should be at its peak within 3 to 5 years.
