





Poggio al Vento is only produced in exceptional vintages from a selection of the best grapes form a seven-hectare area of old vines. The 2013 Poggio al Vento Brunello Riserva exhibits buoyant and lifted aromatics on opening, with fresh red plum, dried Mediterranean herbs, dried roses, and dusty earth. The palate is more linear with tangy, red plum fruit, tea leaf, and thyme. The 2013 still has a ton of tannin grip, but acidity holds the edge here. It was aged for four years in French and Slavonian casks before bottling. Enjoy over the next fifteen years, 2022-2036.
