



TERROIR SENSE WINE REVIEW

Bright dark red. Very closed on the nose but hints at good underlying sweetness with plenty of red fruit, sweet spices and classic elegance. The rich ripe and ample in the typical style of 2015 Brunellos, but with outstanding reserve to its ripe red cherry, strawberry coulis, porcini, nutmeg and peppery flavours that ahs me thinking I was in the southern Rhone.

This is a really beautiful wine in the making, one that needs time to show all it has to offer (which is plenty, hence the "plus" sign on my score). I have no doubts this will warrant a higher score in a few years time, so the smart money is on buying a few cases and laying these away; you won't regret it. Drinking window: 2028-2045.
